

# INSTRUCTIONS<sup>★</sup>



1. Print out with page scaling/page resizing set to None or 100%.
2. Cut along black dashed line, set instructions aside for later reference.
3. Fold remaining square diagonally in half to make a triangle. (One set of dashed grey lines.)

*Now then, if you find that your printout got scaled anyway, just fold along one set of dashed grey lines and even up the edges that are too long before you go to Step 4.*

4. Fold that triangle in diagonally in half again to make a smaller triangle. (Second set of dashed grey lines.)

5. With the small triangle before you so that it looks like a pyramid (the point is at the top) and the light blue areas facing down onto your table top, fold in the left and right points at 75° and 105° respectively. (The solid grey lines.)

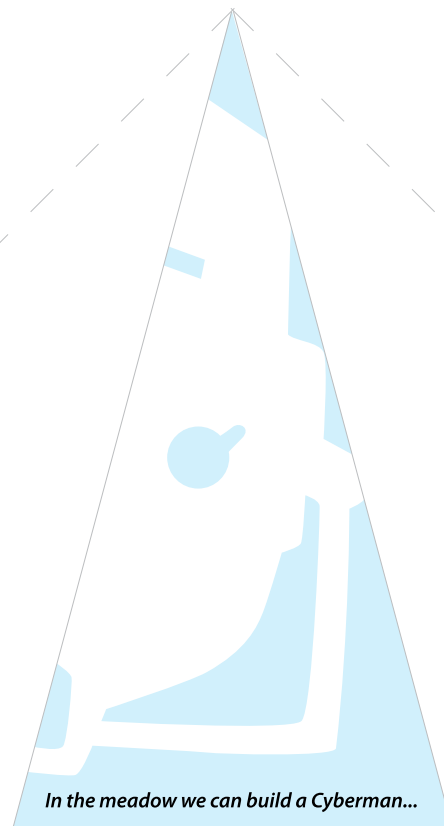
*This gives you a shape rather like a Star Fleet communicator badge, but more symmetrical.*

6. Cut the uneven points off the bottom to give you an acute triangle.
7. Cut out and discard the light blue areas of the pattern.
8. Unfold and feel the wibbly-wobbly, timey-wimey-ness!
